Inspects and tests assigned commercial weighing and measuring devices, investigates consumer complaints and completes written reports. Incumbents in the job may require additional training or experience to attain full proficiency in some or all of the job responsibilities.

NOTE: Must be able to lift and handle 50 pounds, multiple times daily. Ability to travel normally requiring a valid driver's license. Also the applicant must hold or be able to acquire a CDL driver's license Class B within 60 days. Must have working knowledge of Windows computer operating system and applications.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Completion of high school diploma or GED and One year of experience in the area of assignment

OR

Completion of two years of college which included 12 semester/20 quarter hours in chemistry or life sciences

OR

Completion of a vocational-technical program in agriculture, environmental science, entomology or a close related field.
