DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: The Pesticide laboratory is located in Tifton, Georgia and is a part of the Georgia Department of Agriculture's Laboratory Division. The Pesticide laboratory is responsible for the testing of pesticides residues in food, pesticides formulations, pesticides complaint samples, and other pesticide samples for the State of Georgia.

Under general laboratory supervision, performs the following duties:

- Collects and prepares laboratory samples or specimens;
- Assists with development and participates in quality assurance;
- Performs laboratory maintenance;
- Performs routine and non-routine analysis;
- Performs laboratory administrative duties;
- Other duties as assigned.
