MONDAY

The Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers and fryers for this week's trading is 93.25¢ based on full truck load lots of ice pack USDA grade "A" sized 2½ to 3 pound birds. 98% (representing 961 loads) of the loads offered have been confirmed within a range of 80.00¢ to 99.73¢ with a final weighted average of 91.98¢ f.o.b. dock or equivalent. The market is generally steady and the live supply is adequate to occasionally short for a demand ranging normal to good. Average weights are desirable to lighter than desired in a few instances. Estimated slaughter today is 4,385,700 head. This compares with 4,339,300 head last Monday.

The f.o.b. dock confirmed final weighted average prices on ice pack parts based on truck load and pool truck load lots for this week's trading are: line run tenders \$2.05 (based on 1,664,000 lbs.); skinless boneless breasts \$1.5950 (based on 7,432,000 lbs.); whole breasts \$1.0050 (based on 1,424,000 lbs.); boneless skinless thigh meat \$1.3050 (based on 1,149,000 lbs.); thighs 72.00¢ (based on 1,107,000 lbs.); drumsticks 72.00¢ (based on 1,282,000 lbs.); leg quarters 54.00¢ (based on 9,479,000 lbs.); and wings \$1.8850 (based on 3,658,000 lbs.). Demand on all parts ranges good to normal, mostly good; with the exception of boneless skinless thigh meat, thighs and leg quarters which is normal to good.

TUESDAY

The Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers and fryers for this week's trading is 93.25¢. The final weighted average was 91.98¢ f.o.b. dock or equivalent. The market tone for next week's trading is unchanged and the live supply is adequate for a mostly balanced demand. Average weights are desirable with an occasionally weak to firm, mostly steady price trend. Estimated slaughter today is 4,570,500 head. This compares with 4,458,700 head last Tuesday.

The f.o.b. dock confirmed final weighted average prices on parts were: line run tenders \$2.05; skinless boneless breasts \$1.5950; whole breasts \$1.0050; boneless skinless thigh meat \$1.3050; thighs 72.00¢; drumsticks 72.00¢; leg quarters 54.00¢; and wings \$1.8850. Cooler inventories and supplies on all parts are balanced. Price trend on line run tenders and skinless boneless breasts is weak to firm, mostly steady; whole breast and leg quarters is steady to firm; boneless skinless thigh meat is steady to weak; thighs and drumsticks is firm; while the price trend on wings ranges weak to firm, mostly weak to steady.

WEDNESDAY

The Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers and fryers for next week's trading remains unchanged at 93.25¢ based on full truck load lots of ice pack USDA grade "A" sized 2½ to 3 pound birds. The market is steady and the live supply is adequate to occasionally short for a normal to good demand. Average weights are ranging desirable to occasionally light, but are mostly desirable. Estimated slaughter today is 4,599,400 head. This compares with 4,562,100 head last Wednesday.

The f.o.b. dock quoted prices on ice pack parts based on truck load and pool truck load lots for next week's trading are: line run tenders \$2.0350; skinless boneless breasts \$1.5850; whole breasts \$1.0050; boneless skinless thigh meat \$1.31; thighs 72.50¢; drumsticks 66.50¢; leg quarters 54.00¢; and wings \$1.89. Demand on line run tenders, skinless boneless breasts, whole breasts and drumsticks is good to normal, mostly good; while the demand on boneless skinless thigh meat, thighs, leg quarters and wings ranges normal to good.

THURSDAY

The Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers and fryers for this week's trading is 93.25¢ based on full truck load lots of ice pack USDA grade "A" sized 2½ to 3 pound birds. 58% (representing 568 loads) of the loads offered have been confirmed within a range of 86.97¢ to 99.75¢ with a preliminary weighted average of 92.62¢ f.o.b. dock or equivalent. The market is steady and the live supply is generally adequate for a good to occasionally light, mostly normal demand. Average weights are ranging desirable to occasionally light, but are mostly desirable. Estimated slaughter today is 4,573,200 head. This compares with 4,569,700 head last Thursday.

FRIDAY

The Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers and fryers for this week's trading is 93.25¢ based on full truck load lots of ice pack USDA grade "A" sized 2½ to 3 pound birds. 75% (representing 734 loads) of the loads offered have been confirmed within a range of 86.97¢ to 96.75¢ with a preliminary weighted average of 92.61¢ f.o.b. dock or equivalent. The market continues steady and the live supply is adequate to occasionally short for a normal to good demand. Average weights are ranging desirable to slightly light. Estimated slaughter today is 4,845,200 head. This compares with 4,294,900 head last Friday.

The f.o.b. dock confirmed preliminary weighted average prices on ice pack parts based on truck load and pool truck load lots for this week's trading are: line run tenders \$2.06 (based on 1,007,000 lbs.); skinless boneless breasts \$1.60 (based on 4,391,000 lbs.); whole breasts \$1.00¢ (based on 949,000 lbs.); boneless skinless thigh meat \$1.31 (based on 811,000 lbs.); thighs 73.00¢ (based on 737,000 lbs.); drumsticks 72.00¢ (based on 729,000 lbs.); leg quarters 54.00¢ (based on 5,248,000 lbs.); and wings \$1.8850 (based on 2,185,000 lbs.). Demand on line run tenders, thighs, leg quarters and wings ranges normal to good; skinless boneless breasts, whole breasts and boneless skinless thigh meat is good to normal; while the demand on drumsticks is good.

Trading on heavy breeder type hens was fully balanced. The market undertone is mostly unchanged with offerings adequate for normal buying interest. Estimated hen slaughter for the week ending today is 263,100 head. This compares with 149,700 head the same time a year ago.

* Estimated total slaughter for the week ending today for broilers and fryers is 22,974,000 head. This compares with 23,680,700 head of broilers and fryers for the corresponding week a year ago.
