MONDAY

The Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers and fryers for this week's trading is \$1.0625 based on full truck load lots of ice pack USDA grade "A" sized 2½ to 3 pound birds. 100% (representing 1,000 loads) of the loads offered have been confirmed within a range of 88.00¢ to \$1.1095 with a final weighted average of \$1.0429 f.o.b. dock or equivalent. The market is mostly steady to occasionally weak and firm and the live supply is adequate to short for a good to normal demand. Average weights are desirable. Estimated slaughter for today is 4,400,000 head. This compares to 3,593,600 head last Monday.

The f.o.b. dock confirmed final weighted average prices on ice pack parts based on truck load and pool truck load lots for this week's trading are: line run tenders \$2.07 (based on 1,758,000 lbs.); skinless boneless breasts \$1.9850 (based on 7,583,000 lbs.); whole breasts \$1.19 (based on 1,893,000 lbs.); boneless skinless thigh meat \$1.5050 (based on 1,241,000 lbs.); thighs 74.50¢ (based on 1,327,000 lbs.); drumsticks 75.50¢ (based on 1,352,000 lbs.); leg quarters 53.50¢ (based on 9,374,000 lbs.); and wings \$1.44 (based on 3,483,000 lbs.). Demand on most parts is good to normal, mostly good with the exceptions of line run tenders which is good to normal, mostly good, occasionally light, and whole breasts and wings which is normal to good.

10 SEPTEMBER 2013

TUESDAY

The Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers and fryers for this week's trading is \$1.0625. The final weighted average was \$1.0429 f.o.b. dock or equivalent. The market tone for next week's trading is mostly steady to occasionally weak and firm, and the live supply is adequate to short for a good to normal demand. Average weights are desirable with a steady to Tuesday.

The f.o.b. dock confirmed final weighted average prices on parts were: line run tenders \$2.07; skinless boneless breasts \$1.9850; whole breasts \$1.19; boneless skinless thigh meat \$1.5050; thighs 74.50¢; drumsticks 75.50¢; leg quarters 53.50¢; and wings \$1.44. Cooler inventories and supplies on all parts are balanced to occasionally light and heavy with a demand ranging mostly good and balanced to occasionally light. Price trend on all parts is mostly lower to higher, occasionally steady, weak, and firm.

11 SEPTEMBER 2013

WEDNESDAY

The Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers and fryers for next week's trading remains unchanged at \$1.0625 based on full truck load lots of ice pack USDA grade "A" sized 2½ to 3 pound birds. The market is steady to occasionally firm and slightly weak, and the live supply is adequate for a normal to good demand. Average weights are desirable to a little heavy in a few instances. Estimated slaughter today is 4,746,400 head. This compares with 4,744,700 head last Wednesday.

The f.o.b. dock quoted prices on ice pack parts based on truck load and pool truck load lots for next week's trading are: line run tenders \$2.0750; skinless boneless breasts \$1.96; whole breasts \$1.18; boneless skinless thigh meat \$1.56; thighs 73.00¢; drumsticks 66.50¢; leg quarters 53.50¢ and wings \$1.46. Demand on line run tenders and skinless boneless breasts is good to normal, mostly good, occasionally light; demand on whole breasts is normal to good, mostly normal; demand on boneless skinless thigh meat is good to occasionally light; demand on thighs, drumsticks, and leg quarters is good to normal, mostly good; and demand on wings is normal to good.

Note: On September 12, 2012, the Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers and fryers was 95.75¢.

THURSDAY

The Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers and fryers for this week's trading is \$1.0625 based on full truck load lots of ice pack USDA grade "A" sized 2½ to 3 pound birds. 39% (representing 387 loads) of the loads offered have been confirmed within a price range of \$1.0275 to \$1.08 with a preliminary weighted average of \$1.0619 f.o.b. dock or equivalent. The market is steady to slightly firm and a little weak, and the live supply is adequate for a normal to good demand. Average weights are desirable. Estimated slaughter today is 4,747,900 head. This compares with 4,752,200 head last Thursday.

13 SEPTEMBER 2013

FRIDAY

The Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers and fryers for this week's trading is \$1.0625 based on full truck load lots of ice pack USDA grade "A" sized 2½ to 3 pound birds. 86% (representing 863 loads) of the loads offered have been confirmed within a range of 99.90¢ to \$1.1095 with a preliminary weighted average of \$1.0567 f.o.b. dock or equivalent. The market is steady to occasionally weak and slightly firm, and the live supply is adequate to short for a good to normal demand. Average weights are desirable. Estimated slaughter today is 4,718,500 head. This compares with 4,709,200 head last Friday.

The f.o.b. dock confirmed preliminary weighted average prices on ice pack parts based on truck load and pool truck load lots for this week's trading are: line run tenders \$2.11 (based on 1,510,000 lbs.); skinless boneless breasts \$2.0550 (based on 6,222,000 lbs.); whole breasts \$1.2150 (based on 1,210,000 lbs.); boneless skinless thigh meat \$1.55 (based on 1,045,000 lbs.); thighs 74.50¢ (based on 1,218,000 lbs.); drumsticks 75.00¢ (based on 1,079,000 lbs.); leg quarters 53.50¢ (based on 7,909,000 lbs.); and wings \$1.4450 (based on 3,211,000 lbs.). Demand on most parts is good to normal, mostly good with the exception of line run tenders which is good to normal, mostly good, occasionally light.

Estimated hen slaughter for the week ending today is 267,811 head. Estimated hen slaughter for the corresponding week a year ago was 282,946 head.

\* Estimated total slaughter for the week ending today for broilers and fryers is 23,353,600 head. This compares with 23,042,200 head of broilers and fryers for the corresponding week a year ago.
