- Describe Good Agricultural Practices (GAP);
- Identify requirements of the Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) - Produce Safety Rule;
- List microbial risks;
- Implement produce safety practices; and
- Write a food safety plan for the farm.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: Any farmer interested in improving the safety of their produce and learning how to create a food safety plan for the farm. Any produce grower who grows, packs, harvests, and/or holds covered produce; makes over \$25,000 in annual produce sales (on average, based on the past three years of sales); and does not qualify for a Produce Safety Rule exemption is *required* to attend this training under new federal regulations.
