

<b>SUBJECT:</b>	Enforcement Discretion Policy – Gasoline Volatility

Georgia Rule 40-20-1-.01(a)(iv) requires the use of gasoline meeting Class C-3 volatility specifications between September 17 and October 31 for the State of Georgia. Based on information collected on Colonial Pipeline Operation disruptions in the State of Alabama and to facilitate replacement of gasoline supplies, the Georgia Department of Agriculture will exercise enforcement discretion to allow regulated parties to supply gasoline meeting Class D-4 volatility specifications during this time period. This exercise of enforcement discretion will be effective at 12:01 a.m. on September 17 and will continue until midnight on October 31, 2016.
