

Rule 40-16-1-.09. Hazardous Biologicals, Authority to Impound

Biologicals which are determined to be hazardous, and those biologicals not meeting the requirements as set out in these and any other rules and regulations or orders as may be promulgated by the Commissioner of Agriculture of this state and any laws as may pertain thereto, shall be subject to impoundment, confiscation, seizure, and any other action that may be deemed necessary to assure the proper control thereof. Biologicals and test antigens such as Brucella Strain 19 vaccine, Pseudorabies vaccine, Brucella antigen, and tuberculin are restricted for sale to and use by or under direction of a veterinarian accredited by the USDA and licensed under the Georgia Veterinary Practice Act, and employees of the state and federal government approved by the State Veterinarian; provided, however, that rabies vaccine may be sold to and used by or under the direction of any veterinarian licensed under the Georgia Veterinary Practice Act and employees of the state and federal government approved by the State Veterinarian.
