

MINUTES OF THE GEORGIA STRUCTURAL PEST CONTROL COMMISSION MEETING

August 9, 2011

- A. The Georgia Structural Pest Control Commission convened at 9:30 a.m. in Room 201 of the Agriculture Building on August 9, 2011. The following commission members were present: Jimmy Allgood, Chair, Maurice Redmond, Vice-chair, Dr. Brian Forschler.
- B. Also in attendance were Josh Wiley with the Georgia Department of Agriculture, GPCA and CPCO representatives, registrants and other members of the pest management industry.
- C. Motion was made by Mr. Redmond to approve the minutes of the July meeting. Dr. Forschler seconded the motion and motion passed.
- D. The Commission approved company license applications (see Attachment 2).
- E. Mr. Joshua Wiley discussed that the license renewal deadline was June 30, 2011 and that the late renewal deadline is September 30, 2011.
- F. Mr. Allgood asked Rick Bell to discuss rodenticide labeling issues with the EPA. Mr. Bell was happy to announce that EPA was moving forward with revising recently approved rodenticide labels. These revisions include expanding the application distance around a structure from 50ft to 450ft. Mr. Bell indicated that EPA has a set time frame for the change to happen before the end of the year.
- G. Mr. Allgood expressed his concerns with the decline in the use of the Official Georgia Wood Infestation Inspection Report (WIIR) during the purchasing of homes in the state. Mr. Allgood asked the industry members in attendance whether they have notice a similar decline in the use of the WIIR document in their areas, these concerns were echoed back from the audience. Mr. Allgood ask that the pest control industry continue to be diligent in requesting that lenders utilize the WIIR letters for the protection of Georgia home buyers.
- H. Dr. Forschler discussed some current news for the University of Georgia. Dr. Dan Suiter will be promoted to a full professor and will take on a master student this year. Dr. Hinkle had a student graduate from her program this year and Dr. Forschler had two student graduates from his program this year as well. One of these graduates identified and named a new termite species native to Georgia, making a total of five (5) identified native termites in the state. The other student is Sonya, she worked on compiling a large data set derived from school inspections performed by the Department of Agriculture. This research is targeted at assisting both the pest control industry and the Department to identify violations and geographical trends for pesticide application to Georgia schools.
- I. Mr. Wiley discussed possible labeling issues during the application of the pesticide Delta Dust for bed bugs infestations. Mr. Wiley read aloud from the application section of the Delta Dust label, the instructions indicated specific areas the product was to be applied and clean up directions to be followed after the application is completed. Mr. Wiley explained that if a pest control company making this type of application is not performing required cleanup of the product, that company must indicate on the pesticide use record the specific

areas treated so that the homeowner performing the clean up can meet the label requirements.
