Pursuant to the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, O.C.G.A. § 50-13-4 and O.C.G.A. § 2-23-12, notice is hereby given that the Georgia Department of Agriculture will accept written comments regarding the proposed adoption of GA. Comp. R. & Regs. r. 40-32-5-.06 (the "Rule"). The Department will accept written comments from Thursday, August 8, 2024, until the close of business (4:30 p.m. ET) on Friday, September 6, 2024.

## **SYNOPSIS:**

### **Synopsis:**

The Department seeks to adopt the Rule to reflect the changes to the Georgia Hemp Farming Act, O.C.G.A. § 2-23-1 et seq., made by Ga. L. 2024, SB 494.

The Rule proposes a maximum serving size and serving limit for total delta-9-THC concentration in consumable hemp products in consideration of consumer health, safety, and potential accidental misuse.

The Department expects the Rule to be effective after adoption and appropriate filing with the Georgia Secretary of State.
