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To All Licensed Hemp Growers:

This letter is a reminder of the recordkeeping and reporting requirements for Licensed Hemp Growers that is contained in 40-32-2-.10 of the Georgia Hemp Growers and Processors Rule (see [GA - GAC - Chapter 40-32. HEMP GROWERS AND PROCESSORS](#)).

As you know, each Licensed Hemp Grower is required to provide crop information to the USDA Farm Service Agency (or FSA). The deadline established by FSA for this information is **July 31, 2022**. Please visit <https://www.fsa.usda.gov/state-offices/Georgia/index> if you are unsure how to contact your local FSA office. Below is some basic information that producers need to provide when reporting acreage to FSA:

- Crop and crop type or variety.
- Intended use of the crop.
- Number of acres of the crop.
- Planting date(s).
- Planting pattern, when applicable.
- Producer shares.
- Irrigation practice(s).
- Acreage prevented from planting, when applicable.
- AMS License Number- if not already on file with FSA
- Other information as required.
